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Design 23 – Nordic Knits 2

**PULLOVER
ECOPUNO & SETASURI**

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Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46, 48 – 50)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: **350 (400, 450, 500) g** of Lana Grossa **Ecopuno** (72% cotton, 17% Merino wool, 11% baby alpaca; 215 m/50 g) in Ecreu (**col 46**); **175 (200, 225, 250) g** of Lana Grossa **Setasuri** (69% Suri alpaca, 31% silk; 212 m/25 g) in Cream (**col 02**). Size 3.5 and 4.5 mm needles.

Note: Work with 1 strand of each yarn held tog throughout = 2 strands held tog.

Rib patt: K2, p2.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Chart patt A and B: Numbers at right edge of charts indicate RS rows; on WS rows purl all sts and yos. Position sts as given in instructions. Rep rows 1 – 28.

Selvage stitches: On every row: Sl first st kwise, k last st.

Gauge: 19 sts and 28 rows = 10 x 10 cm in chart patt A and B with size 4.5 mm needles and 2 strands held tog.

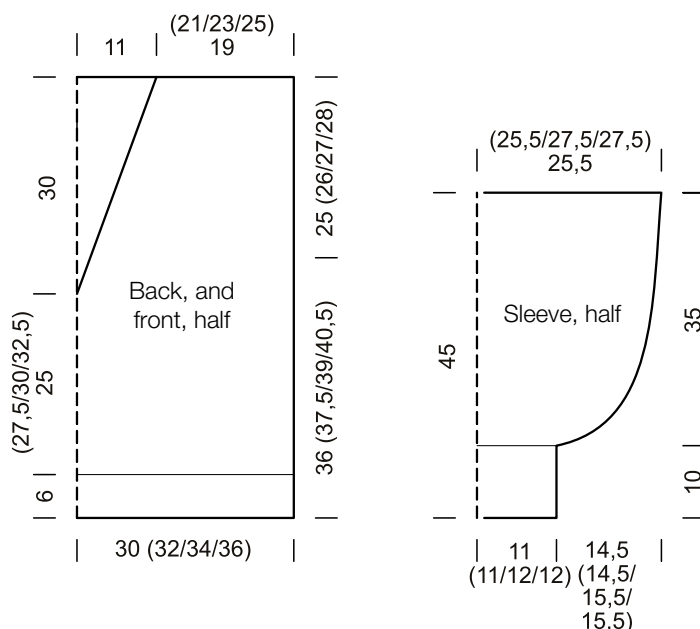
Back: With size 3.5 mm needles and 2 strands held tog cast on 112 (120, 128, 136) sts. Beg and end with a WS row work in rib patt for 6 cm. Work in St st for 2 rows, increasing 3 sts evenly across last row = 115 (123, 131, 139) sts. Change to size 4.5 mm needles. Next row (RS): Work row 1 (21, 15, 7) of chart A (B, A, B): Work 9 (5, 9, 5) sts to patt rep, work 16-st patt rep 6 (7, 7, 8) times, work to end of chart = 10 (6, 10, 6) sts. Work chart A (B, A, B) for a total of 154 (162, 168, 176) rows: Work rows [1 – 28] 5 times, then work rows 1 – 14 once more (rows 21 – 28 once, [rows 1 – 28] 5 times), then work rows 1 – 14 once more / rows 15 – 28 once, rows [1 – 28] 5 times, then work rows 1 – 14 once more / rows 7 – 28 once, rows [1 – 28] 5 times, then work rows 1 – 14 once more). **At same time**, when piece meas 30 (31.5, 33, 34.5) from end of rib patt, place marker in first and last st on last WS row to indicate beg of armholes. Bind off all sts.

Front: Work same as back until chart A (B, A, B) has been worked for a total of 70 (78, 84, 92) rows = 25 (27.5, 30, 32.5) cm: Work rows [1 – 28] 2 times, then work rows 1 – 14 once

more (rows 21 – 28 once, rows [1 – 28] 2 times), then work rows 1 – 14 once more / rows 15 – 28 once, rows [1 – 28] 2 times, then work rows 1 – 14 once more / rows 7 – 28 once, rows [1 – 28] 2 times, then work rows 1 – 14 once more). Shape V-neck: Next row (RS): Bind off center st. Working each side separately, dec 1 st at each neck edge every alt RS row 21 times as foll: At left front, work to last 5 sts, k2tog, k2, selvage st; at right edge work selvage st, k2, skp, work to end. Work 1 WS row. Bind off rem 36 (40, 44, 48) sts for each shoulder.

Sleeves: With size 3.5 mm needles and 2 strands held tog cast on 52 (52, 56, 56) sts. Beg and end with a WS row work in rib patt for 10 cm. Work in St st for 2 rows, increasing 47 (47, 51, 51) sts evenly on last row = 99 (99, 107, 107) sts. Work chart A (A, B, B) for 35 cm. Loosely bind off all sts.

Finishing: Sew shoulder seams. **Neckband:** With size 3.5 mm needles and 2 strands held tog, pick up and k 172 sts evenly around neck edge: 42 sts along back, 65 sts along left front and 65 sts along right front neck edge. Work in rib patt for 5 cm. Bind off all sts. Lap right front band over left front band and sew through both thicknesses at bottom of center V. Sew on sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams. Pin piece to measurements and block.



Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
